The program funds projects that involve wildlife-focused research, education, habitat enhancement, and rehabilitation activities. Examples of projects funded through Share with Wildlife include wildlife species surveys, K-12 educational programs, and wildlife rehabilitation facilities that help to care for and heal sick and injured wildlife.
