Archery Range Rules

Traditional, compound and crossbows are allowed on this range.

- All shooting must be to the north.
- Keep your arrows in your quiver until you are ready to shoot
- Always keep your arrows pointed down or towards the target
- Always walk at the archery range
- Always be absolutely sure that the path to the target and beyond is clear
- Only release the bow string at full draw when there is an arrow on the string. "Dry Firing" may
 cause damage to the bow and is dangerous
- Keep arrow level while drawing, do not "high draw."
- Secure all loose clothing, remove bracelets, necklaces, etc. Tie long hair back.
- Pull your arrows out one at a time, and put them in your guiver.
- Work with other shooters. Whenever the line is called safe or cold and shooters are down range
 ALL bows MUST be removed from the firing line and made safe. At NO TIME should any shooter
 handle, work on, or otherwise touch their respective bows while people are present down range.
- Clean up and remove all trash including target materials, dispose of properly. NO DUMPING.
- Alcohol and controlled substances ARE NOT PERMITTED.
- No shooter under 18 may use the range facilities without adult supervision
